

Towngate Primary Academy

The following is a summary of how Towngate Primary Academy has spent the 2017-2018 PE and Sport Grant of £18,120 Our identified areas for development are as follows:

Healthy Lifestyles

Total Expenditure: £5,937.60

Action:

- To embed the good practice we have established we have decided to appoint a part-time sports development coach to work alongside experienced practitioners to develop their own skills and disseminate good practice regarding health and fitness.
- To further develop the range of extracurricular activities to give children extra opportunities to take part in physical activity.
- To enhance playground facilities and resources to improve behaviour of an identified group and give all the children a chance to get an extra 45 minutes of exercise a day, through an active lunch time.
- To establish 'Maths of the day' an energetic and active way to approach maths.

Physical Education

Total expenditure: £10,411.28

Action:

- To further develop a wider range of physical activities to meet the requirements of the national curriculum by employing a specialist teacher of dance for two afternoons a week, to enhance provision and develop the skills of existing staff.
- To work with the class teachers to put on a showcase of dance skills to raise the profile and increase engagement of children in dance and signpost children to the dance school.
- To develop intra sports provision and the skills and capabilities of in school teachers, an additional sports specialist teacher will be employed for one day to work with teachers in years 3, 4, 5 and 6.
- A full programme of progression will be set up including skills, using and applying, health, social and evaluation to make it easier for teachers to plan and deliver their lessons.
- To develop Outdoor and adventurous activities through KS2 for all children.

Club and competitive school sport

Total expenditure £1,500

- To support **all** children taking part in more inter sport competitions across the MAT and Ossett Pyramid.
- To create the opportunity for team building skills, thinking skills, socials skills and sportsmanship through inter sport events
- To give children opportunity to take part in out of school activities.
