Re: Extra-Curricular Activities

Please find attached sign-up sheet for the internal extra-curricular activities that we are offering at lunch time and afterschool. **Please note that all our afterschool club sessions finish at 4.15 pm promptly, and all children will need to be collected from school at the end of the session by a parent or carer.** Registers will be taken at all sessions and absences will be followed up on, so as we expect demand to be high, please ensure you let the school office know if your child is unable to attend or has changed their mind about attending so that their place can be offered to a child on the waiting list. 
AFTERSCHOOL: KS2 Multi-Sports (Year 3,4,5,6)
