Events in the academy this week

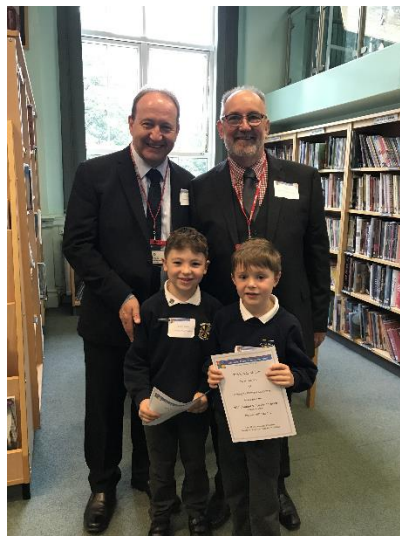
Year 5 & 6 football
